Approval of the City of McKenzie Harmony Park, Mulberry Park and McKenzie City Park to receive playground equipment - LPRF

Background / Analysis:

The City of McKenzie has applied for and awarded a Local Park Recreation Fund grant concerning the need for playground equipment within Harmony Park, Mulberry Park and the McKenzie City Park.

From RTP Grant Manual page 14:

Municipal Planning Commission Review

POLICY: Per Tenn. Code Ann. § 13-4-104 Municipal governments must present capital projects to their local Planning Commission for review.

PROCEDURE: To meet Tenn. Code Ann. § 13-4-104 municipal Awarded Organizations must present the grant project to their local planning commission for approval. Upon approval a copy of the planning commission meeting minutes approving the grant project must be uploaded to the GMS. In the event the local planning commission does not approve the grant project, the municipal government must present the project to their local board for approval. Approval by the local board will override the local planning commission's disapproval. Upon approval a copy of the municipal board meeting minutes approving the grant project must be uploaded to the GMS.

Discussion: Jennifer Waldrup, city recorder, made a presentation to the commission members regarding the equipment which would be installed at the three parks. There was limited discussion before the question was called.
