6. Discussion/Approval on the purchase of a new police car for the police department

Discussion:

Vice Mayor Hale explained to the Council the need to purchase a new police car. He stated the current police cars were piling on the miles and the maintenance cost was getting to be very expensive for the department. He told the council they were looking at a new 2012 Dodge Charger with a V6 instead of the V8 that came in the Crown Vic. The new Dodge would be much cheaper to operate. The cost of the new police car is \$22,718 and would be paid for by the \$8,500 from TML insurance for the salvage value of the BMW motorcycle and the balance would come from the drug fund account. He said this would give the police department 11cars to use on the road. All cars that were taken off the road could be sold on

the government auction and monies from the sale of the cars would go back into the general fund.
